**A: Sea Promenade**

Total length 417.5m. Ito Marine Road is a sea promenade that uses a breakwater.

When you take a walk while looking at the surrounding sea, you will feel like you are walking on the sea.

An increasingly popular Instagram spot. You can take photos with the sea in the background and cute seagulls. If you take a good photo, please upload it to social media!

Opening hours: 11:00-15:00

Closed: The facility will be closed in the event of rain, strong winds, or maintenance.



## B: Footbath

Atamari-na is a free hot spring footbath with a total length of 43m and a capacity of 70 people. This is a very popular footbath where you can relax while looking at the ocean that spreads out before you. The hot spring in the footbath is a luxurious "flowing water".

Opening hours: 10:00-16:00

Closed: Closed on rainy days



### C: Terrace with telescope

A spot where you can see the whole of Sagami Bay over the cruisers and yachts moored at the marina.

You can see Hatsushima Island in Atami City, Oshima Island in Tokyo, and the uninhabited island of Teishijima.

There is also a face-in panel here, and table seats are available for free use.

You can eat takeout food here.



### D: Face-in panel

There are three in the facility.

You can take cute photos by peeking your head out from the panel featuring Ito Marine Town's characters, Mari-nyan and Captain Seagull.



### E: Blue Postbox of Happiness

Japanese postboxes are usually red, but the postboxes at Ito Marine Town are painted marine blue in honor of the sea. Cylindrical postboxes are rare nowadays, and are a nostalgic shape for Japanese people. Of course, it's a real postbox, so you can post letters there.

The panel behind the postbox changes with the seasons, and it's also a great photo spot.



### F: Heart Photo Stand

A photo stand with heart-shaped illuminations. You can take photos with the acrylic panels of Mari-nyan and Captain Seagull. There's also a camera stand, which is convenient. Be sure to post the photos you take on social media!
